Cognitive Demands

Accuplacer/ACT/SAT scores demonstrating college-level reading ability.

Accuplacer/ACT/SAT scores demonstrating placement into English Composition I (ENG 121).

Accuplacer/ACT/SAT scores demonstrating placement into Career Math/Technical Math (MAT 107/108) for students in the certificate program or placement in College Algebra (MAT 121) for students in the degree program.

Physical Demands

Standing	Periodically
Sitting	For extended periods of time
Manual Dexterity	Sufficient to manipulate objects in a variety of sizes (small to large)
Motor Function	Sufficient to write and/or operate a computer for a minimum of 2 hours
Speech	Sufficient for communication in a variety of environments
Hearing	Sufficient for communication in a variety of environments
Vision	Sufficient ability to use a computer and read business documents
