



**2020 Summer Kids' Arts Camps
Protocol for following guidelines due to COVID19**

- CMC is adhering to the guidelines established by the State of Colorado and the Garfield County Department of Health.
- Class sizes: 10 or fewer per class, in separate classrooms.
- Staff and students will be screened each day upon arrival.
- Distancing is required in classrooms and in transition times between classes.
- Facial coverings will be worn during drop-off and pick-up times, class transitions and whenever possible in the classrooms.
- The hygiene rules will be reviewed daily with the children. Students must fully agree to follow the rules for hygiene and to understand that there will be consequences if they choose not to.
- Students will arrive outside of the CMC building, utilizing the 2 entrances (front entrances and side entrance). There will be 10 or fewer students at each entry point and they will be distanced. Teachers will accompany them to the same place outside for parent pick-up. Only registered students will be allowed in the building, no parents or visitors will be allowed inside the building during the camps.
- The students will stay in the same cohort of 10 or fewer in their group and will not intermingle with other groups.
- There will be very limited use of the CMC building during our camps and therefore we believe we will be able to comply with the social distancing

guidelines.

- In place of a showcase at the end of camp, our goal is to provide a virtual showcase (more details to come, as we make these arrangements).
- Instructors are required to understand the full details of the guidelines and to agree to follow them.
- Students will be responsible for bringing the following every day of camp:
 - Their own water bottle with their name on it
 - A snack or their lunch if attending the all-day camp
 - Facial Covering
 - Hand Sanitizer

We are looking forward to having camp this year! Although things might look a little different, we know that the kids will have fun!

We are required by the State of Colorado and Garfield County Public Health to make sure students and teachers are safe and comfortable and that they stay healthy. We will work together as a team to make sure students improve their skill, make friends, and enjoy expressing themselves through art and movement!

As we are all aware these are unprecedented times and information and regulations are changing frequently, please know that we are doing everything we can to ensure these camps will run under the State and local government along with CMC regulations. The safety of your child and our staff is our number one concern. If we must cancel these camps due to changing COVID19 regulations before the camp begins you will be refunded your 90% of your tuition. If we must cancel after the camp has started your refund will be prorated.

Once the child is registered, parents will receive an email with a waiver that will need to be signed and returned before the start of camp.

PARENT GUIDANCE:

For the 9:30 -12:00 Camp for 3.5 – 7 year-olds:

- Students will be divided by age into two groups.
- Students will meet outside by the 2 entrance doors. Teachers will take them

to their first class that will be upstairs. Teachers will supervise them during snack and break time. They will go downstairs for their dance class (with a yoga class on Fridays). Teachers will accompany them outside for pick-up.

- Wear clothes for moving and creating! Wear close-toed shoes for walking through the building. Bring a paint smock or big shirt for cover-up for art class. For dance and movement classes, plan for bare feet or ballet shoes (socks or footed tights are too slippery).
- Bring a water bottle (there will be no access to the drinking fountains) and one tidy snack (please don't bring lots of snacks due to the time allotted).
- Bring a favorite stuffed animal that we will use in the creative dance class.
- Each child will have own chair for belongings. The chairs will be 6 feet apart.

For the 9:40 - 4:10 Camp for 6 – 14 year-olds

- Students will be divided by age into two groups.
- Students will meet at 9:40 outside by the 2 entrance doors. Teachers will take them to their first class (dance) that will be downstairs.
- Wear clothes for moving and creating! Wear close-toed shoes for walking through the building. Bring a paint smock or big shirt for cover-up for art class. For dance and movement classes, plan for bare feet or ballet shoes, or if a soft shoe or sneaker is more comfortable, that is allowed (but the shoes should be clean, and can be left in the building through the camp session; socks or footed tights are too slippery).
- Bring water bottle (there will be no access to the drinking fountains); nutritious snacks (there will be no access to the vending machines); and a nutritious lunch.
- Each child will have a chair for belongings. The chairs will be 6 feet apart.
- Camp will end at 4:10 and students will be outside (accompanied by instructors) for pick-up at the same location where they entered.
