Although students may be admitted to the college, the following program requirements must be met before enrollment in this specific program or course.

Cognitive Demands

Accuplacer/ACT/SAT scores demonstrating college-level reading ability.

Accuplacer/ACT/SAT scores demonstrating placement into English Composition I (ENG 121).

Accuplacer/ACT/SAT scores demonstrating placement into Career Math/Technical Math (MAT 107/108).

Ability to communicate clearly

Ability to comprehend and follow instructions

Ability to learn and use complex computer software

Ability to complete work in a timely manner (e.g. meet deadlines)

Physical Demands

Lifting/Balancing/Carrying 50 lbs. to 100 lbs.

Vision A minimum corrected vision of 20/30.
Ability to see all the visual colors of the spectrum; no major color blindness.
Reasonable night vision.

Manual Dexterity Sufficient to manipulate delicate instruments

Other No severe allergies to photographic chemicals.
