1. The Board of Trustees is the governing body of Colorado Mountain College, established pursuant to C.R.S. § 23-71-110(1).
2. The Board shall consist of seven members as authorized by C.R.S. § 23-71-110(1), one from each of seven Board Member districts as defined below.
3. The Board shall have the authority, responsibility, rights, privileges, powers, and duties granted by Colorado statute and customarily exercised by governing boards of institutions of higher education. The Board is ultimately responsible for the governance of the College and shall carry out the duties and powers as set forth in the Local District College Organization Act, including the specific powers set forth in C.R.S. § 23-71-122 and the duties set forth in C.R.S. § 23-71-123.
4. The Board may delegate specific duties and powers to the College President and the Administration to the extent permitted by law and to the extent determined appropriate by the Board.
