## 1. Grants

The Board delegates to the College President the authority to apply for grants deemed appropriate to further the College mission. Prior Board approval is not required, except for any grants that expressly require approval of the Board.

All grants shall be reviewed to determine consistency with the College’s vision, mission, and the College’s readiness and capacity for administering the grant.

The internal allocation of indirect costs related to grants shall be directed to the Grants office unless the College President approves a different distribution for selected grants.

## 2. Institutional Review Board

The College shall maintain an Institutional Review Board responsible for ensuring that all research activities involving human subjects conducted at or sponsored by Colorado Mountain College have adequate safeguards to protect the rights, dignity, and welfare of the human research subjects.

The College President shall develop procedures to implement this policy.
