Graduation requirements for each degree and certificate program are outlined in the Colorado Mountain College (CMC) Catalog. The catalog that is current at the time a student begins a program shall be used to establish graduation requirements.

The catalog in force, or catalog of record requirement, is based on the Colorado Mountain College academic year, which, beginning in the 2017-18 academic year, runs from fall semester to fall semester. The academic year is defined as fall, spring, and summer semesters. Students who do not maintain continuous enrollment (summers excluded) lose the right to use the original catalog requirements and must use the catalog in force at the time of re-enrollment.

Continuous enrollment for this purpose is defined as the successful completion at Colorado Mountain College of at least three (3) credit hours, which are applicable to the program requirements including any developmental courses required, within the previous three (3) semesters including the summer semester. Students also have the option of selecting the catalog that is in force at the time they apply for graduation, or a catalog between those years.

When completing a bachelor’s degree, associate degree, or certificate of occupational proficiency program, a graduation petition must be submitted. All financial obligations to the college must be fulfilled prior to graduation.
