All students have the right of freedom of speech, inquiry, expression, and assembly by orderly means that does not infringe upon the rights of others or impede a positive learning environment for all students, faculty, administrators, and staff. The College retains the right to reasonably regulate the time, place, and manner of speeches, meetings, functions, protests, posting of written materials, and other activities to ensure the safety of individuals, the protection of property, and the continuity of the education process.

The College President or designee shall promulgate such procedures as may be necessary for the implementation of this policy.
