1. Federal Programs

The College participates in the Federal Pell Grant Program, the Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG) Program, the Federal Work-Study Program, and the Federal Direct Loan Program under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965.

All federal student financial assistance programs are administered following the most current Department of Education regulations regarding Title IV as published in the Federal Register. The Federal Register and the current edition of the Student Financial Aid Handbook serve as the primary, authoritative sources of information on federal financial assistance programs.

The College also assists with student financial assistance programs administered by the Colorado Commission on Higher Education (CCHE).

2. Applications and Reports

Every four years, the College shall complete a Program Participation Agreement with the U.S. Department of Education for the Federal Pell Grant Program, the Federal SEOG Program, the Federal Work-Study Program, and the Federal Direct Loan Program. Under this agreement, the College shall comply with collecting, publishing, and disseminating required consumer disclosures including Basic Consumer Information Requirements; Student Right-to-Know Disclosures; Equity in Athletics; Loan Counseling; Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention Information; Campus Security; and Family Education Rights and Privacy Act. The specific disclosures include but are not limited to: Net Price Calculator, Textbook Information, Gainful Employment, FERPA Notification, Voter Registration, and Satisfactory Academic Progress policies.
