The Board has determined that its duties with regard to personnel matters set forth in Section 23-71-123, Colorado Revised Statutes, would be more efficiently administered if delegated to the College President and other officers of the College as authorized by Section 23-5-117, Colorado Revised Statutes.

Accordingly, the Board hereby delegates to the President all of its power over personnel matters, including the power to hire or to fire employees, except as reserved to the board below. The President is expressly authorized to delegate any such power to any Vice President, Campus executive officer, or Chief Human Resource Officer, provided that the president remains responsible for proper exercise of powers.

The Board reserves and retains the authority, after consultation with faculty representatives chosen by the faculty, to prepare, enact, promulgate, administer, and maintain in place policies and practices which afford due process procedures for those faculty members who are terminated, including termination resulting from reductions in force pursuant to Section 23-5-117, Colorado Revised Statutes.
