Pursuant to CRS 23-1-125 (4), the College is authorized to provide competency based testing opportunities for its students. Notwithstanding any requirements to the contrary as provided by CMC Board Policy or found in Colorado State law, the CMC Board of Trustees authorizes the President to establish administrative fees for competency based testing at rates not to exceed 50% of the college's published tuition rate, according to the student's official tuition classification. The Board also authorizes the President to establish unique or differential administrative fee structures for competency based testing that conform to organizational agreements, including but not limited to concurrent enrollment agreements with school districts in the CMC tax district, provided such rates not exceed 50% of the college's published tuition rates according to the student's official tuition classification. This policy applies to competency-based assessments delivered by CMC and excludes exams administered by other agencies, such as AP, IB, and CLEP/DANTES, which will be evaluated according to existing college policies, CCHE policies, and Colorado State laws.
