CMC Trustee policy 6.30 requires all employees of Colorado Mountain College to reside in the state of Colorado while employed with the college. This requirement eliminates the need for CMC to obtain business and employment licenses or to interpret and follow employment laws and procedures required by other states.

Student hourly workers, including work study students, are exempt from this requirement when they are active students at the college, either during or between academic terms.

Approved vendors and contractors may reside outside of Colorado, but must meet all eligibility guidelines specified by the college's business office.
